Good Neighbor Grants Program

The Good Neighbor Grant program provides financial assistance for community members who have unmet health and wellness needs.

2016 was another record year - OHF approved 268 Good Neighbor Grants which was more than double the 133 grants done in 2015.

OHF HIRS Caregiver Referral Service

The Caregiver Referral Service connects people needing in-home caregivers to community caregivers and agencies. In 2016 we connected 39 families with Caregivers and In- Home Services.

HIRS Respite Grants are available for up to \$1,000 per year for people who need respite from in-home caregiving who are otherwise unable to afford to pay for a respite provider or services.

In 2016 OHF Provided 9 Respite Grants totaling \$7,095.

OHF SMILES

OHF SMILES is a place based oral health assessment program providing screenings, tooth brush cleanings, Education and fluoride varnish from a licensed Dental Hygienist as well as Care Coordination in an effort to reduce the amount of adults in the Upper Valley presenting with urgent oral health needs.

This year we provided 60 SMILES Grants in partnership with Alice Peck Day Hospital totaling \$13,424 in dental care.

The Mindful SELF

At the end of 2015 we launched a new Mental Health Initiative with a focus on Prevention and Early Childhood Intervention Treatment for Youth and their Families. Out of this the Mindful SELF Program was created which will officially launch in 2017 as a Social/Emotion Learning and Wellness Program soon to be

in 3 elementary schools for grades Pre-K to 6 with an emphasis on teaching children focused attention, body awareness, and kindness towards self and others.

Community Health Education and Grants

This year OHF provided \$49,896 of funding in support of the following programs:

The Bugbee Senior Center, Dr. Angelo Volandes, The Killington Elementary School, The Purple Crayon, 2 Showings of Glenn Campbell’s movie “I’ll Be Me”, Expert Speaker Cindy Pierce, and a screening of Bess O’Brien’s documentary “All of Me”.

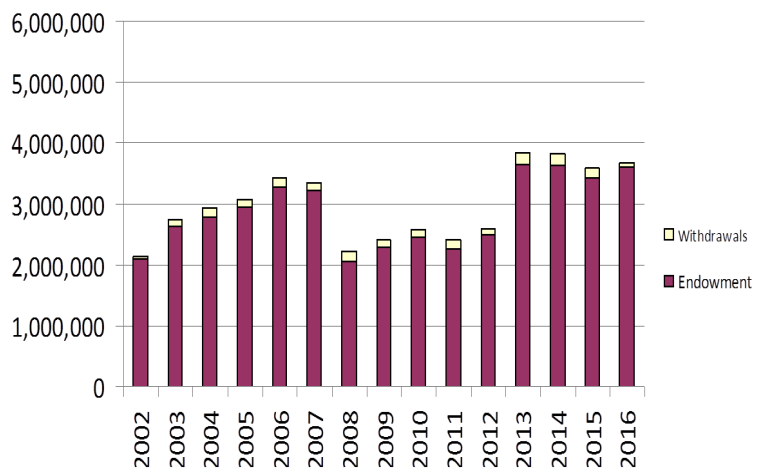
